Internationalization at home: Collaborations to build confidence

In today's globalized society, networks, and international affiliations are becoming especially vital in developing international collaboration and creating confidence and understanding among nations, with universities and colleges all over the world collaborating and exchanging information and ideas. This has resulted in the establishment of an increasing number of networks and international groups in higher education, to encourage cooperation and collaboration among institutions and individuals. As a result, any Indian higher education institutions are becoming more committed to broadening their global reach as possibilities to attract overseas students, professors, and financing growth.

"Internationalization at home" has become a requirement as the variety of the university grows and students go for postsecondary learning overseas. (Internationalization at home refers to actions on the home institutions that encourage the internationalization of university education, such as bringing international students and overseas distinguished guests.) Some research indicates that India is one of the countries with the largest private higher education systems. India has been designated as the world's largest one among these, with private higher education and enrollees



close to 64.3%.

Internationalization refers to all forms of cross-border education, including student, teacher, and scholar mobility, as well as programs, courses, curricula, and initiatives. Internationalization at Home contains indirect references to such programs and is not exclusive to it. All these approaches being taken forward in that lane are aimed at integrating international course content into a common curriculum while fostering teacher and student participation in a heterogeneous learning environment that leads to intercultural. It promotes the concept that any student, not just those participating in international mobility programs,

may benefit from having a global learning opportunity directly on their college campus without having to move abroad if they cannot afford to do so. In addition to the structured learning received from the shared program material, students may benefit from the general experience of collaborating with classmates from different institutions.

The capacity to aggregate resources and knowledge is one of the most essential advantages of multinational institutions across the world. Working together, member nations can do far more than they could alone. International higher education associations are organizations that connect institutions, researchers, and educators from all over the globe to address specific challenges such as enhancing sci-

entific research, encouraging sustainable development, or increasing access to higher education. These organizations provide a venue for members to share resources and skills, as well as collaborate on common goals. The International Association of Universities (IAU), for example, strives to promote university education as an essential human right and to foster university development worldwide.

Though internationalization at home must be viewed from the perspective of the organizations involved and the academic outcomes, in the end, the students are the ones who will benefit from it. Internationalization at home ensures that all students, including those who have never had mobility experiences, have their say and consider their perspective in conceptualizing the idea. The intentional focus on all learners in the course of study distinguishes internationalization at home. Internationalization at Home is supplied in addition to the official, assessed curriculum through the informal curriculum, which are non-assessed components of the student experience that are still provided by or affiliated with the institution.

There are several strategies proposed to put the internationalization process into practice, some of which include: providing all students with diverse

perspectives within their course of study, regardless of whether they spend time abroad so that they can develop a global citizen attitude even if they are not involved in any mobility programs; Beginning to develop international and multicultural views through internationalized learning outcomes in the formal curriculum; supports informal co-curriculum activities across the institution. Making intentional use of cultural diversity in the classroom for inclusive learning, teaching, and assessment practice; Involves all employees, not just academics and foreign officers, in creating an ideal learning environment and achieving measurable learning results; engaging in virtual mobility through online working with partner universities; Fostering purposeful engagement with

international students.

One of the most important advantages of networking and multilateral institutions in post-secondary learning is the capacity to bring professionals from all over the world together to work on similar goals. For example, a network of institutions focusing on curriculum enrichment and improvements in the evaluation and educational quality may bring together specialists from many fields to cooperate on initiatives targeted at encouraging relevant practices and studies in higher education. This partnership advances knowledge and comprehension in these areas and can lead to the creation of new programs, activities, and policies that benefit the larger higher education community.

Why, along with healthy children, disabled children (blind, hearing impaired...) do not come to preschool educational institutions and receive an education?

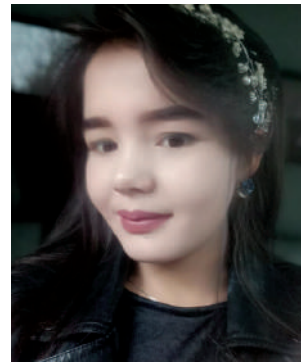
ment that by organizing interesting audiobooks for all types of visually impaired children,

decides to take control of this problem, the situation will continue and our children's thinking will remain stunted. If we create many opportunities to talk with children with disabilities, to increase their thinking, children will develop successfully in all aspects. For this, we need to develop many new projects. We need to organize special audiobooks for visually impaired children and direct them to education. It is necessary to involve disabled, deaf, deaf, and language-impaired children in education. Only then will society develop, and only then will they live a happy life. Based on this, we must develop inclusive education at a stronger level. Supporting inclusive education in our society will make it more meaningful to raise one step.

Student guidance methods and vocational education

Let me talk about personality education and after-school activities.

I also tried to teach personality. I don't know if there is a saying about personality education in foreign countries. In Korea, personality education refers to education that is essential for students to live together, such as education of manners, personality education, community education, and environmental education. We emphasize consideration and cooperation for society. I made students do volunteer work for personality education purposes.

I organized a volunteer club because I thought it was important to give students the right personality through sharing and consideration and to teach students who are continuing their studies to return to a society that helped them.

Volunteering activities were conducted with the talents gained through after-school programs to guide personality education through social and school education and provided students with an opportunity to experience the fact that their talents were useful.

In Korea, volunteer work is included in the regular curriculum at the educational level, and volunteer work is very active. Since 2005, local children's centers have provided community development and sharing personality education through computer guidance, learning guidance, drone education, hands-on activities, facility service, singing and dance performances, community camphor participation, and care for the elderly living alone.

In addition, welding services were provided for facilities broken in farming and fishing villages through welding learned at school, and volunteer work was provided for farming and fishing villages. The students were educated in both technical and personality education necessary for living in society.

As a result, it became the best club among middle and high schools in Korea, and at the same time, it is the club that has the most active volunteer activities. It is the only case in Korea that has won 14 ministerial awards for volunteer work.

I will talk about my vocational education method.

In vocational education, education today is always outdated. Education cannot keep up with the pace of technological development. It develops new high-tech technologies to make profits for corporate purposes, but it has no choice but to educate the technologies that are currently

available. In other words, education is educating the skills of the past.

Basic education is important for students. It is also important to develop the ability to do things on your own. Based on the skills you learned in school, you can go out to society and apply them and show your creativity.

Just because schools provide creative education, not all students can develop creativity. Various experiences and skills

trons came into the machinery sector. It is necessary to have overall basic skills in all areas.

Educating students well and sending them to society is to develop individual students, develop society, and develop the nation. It also contributes to world development.

I achieved the best and most technical education achievements in South Korea, including five guidance on obtaining the most certificates in high schools



are important to students.

Also, students need to develop the ability to do things on their own in school education. In other words, schools teach students how to fish. It's not a place to fish and give it to students. You shouldn't educate students by fishing.

Although it is an automobile major, it has taught the subjects necessary for society in the curriculum. In Korea, the curriculum was operated according to the actual situation of farming and fishing villages because schools can choose subjects autonomously.

I'm an automobile major, but I didn't teach only cars. I am a maintainer of agricultural machinery associated with cars. I taught construction machinery maintenance and made welding basic. I also taught construction machinery operations such as forklifts, excavators, rollers, etc. I also taught Word, Axel, and PowerPoint, which are necessary for modern society. I also taught CAD and 3D printers.

One might ask why you taught so many things like MacGyver.

Students have different personalities and likes. After-school activities allowed students to choose what they like.

And these days, you have to be an expert in your field, but you have to know well other than your field. As technology developed, the meaning of my major disappeared. It has been a long time since electricity and elec-

nationwide and six guidance on obtaining the most certificates for high school students nationwide.

This time, I will talk about how to overcome difficulties.

The Korean education system is excellent. School fees are also fully subsidized by the Office of Education. Provided, That the practice expenses shall not be used other than those items because they are subsidized as the purpose project expenses.

The hardest part is the money needed to run after-school activities.

The school I work for is a rural school. It is difficult to recruit students, and it is not a school where excellent students come. The family situation is also difficult. Looking at it, students work part-time a lot to make a living.

Until 10 years ago, students worked part-time to learn certificates and skills. Because it takes a lot of money to get a license. Students themselves worked part-time to get a certificate because they couldn't apply all the skills they learned at home.

It was unfortunate that such a thing was brought the money from an outside institution through a public offering 10 years ago. After-school activities are expensive. It costs a lot of money to obtain certificates such as students' practice fees and certificate application fees.

If you have a lot of money, you can give it to anyone who needs

Let me talk about my philosophy of education

The school I worked for is a farming and fishing village. Students in farming and fishing villages do not live well compared to the Korean average. They don't have a good family environment. If students go to society without specific skills, it is easy to pass on their poverty. I wanted to break the link of poverty for them. That's

why I kept doing after-school activities until 10 p.m. every night.

My ultimate goal was to make students earn 4.0 million won (which is 3,600 dollars) per month. This amount is about twice the minimum wage in Korea. If someone has skills, he or she can lead a middle-class life in Korea.

I showed students employment notices which are suitable for their aptitude and taught them how to plan and prepare for a certificate so they set their goals accurately.

When students set goals in school life, they try to set goals and do not wander around in adolescence.

On weekends, I talked with students by text message. Students in need can call me at any time. I called the students frequently on weekends. I listened to the difficult situations of the students and gave them directions for studying. I talked with students whenever I had time.

Let me talk about how to encourage students.

People have good points and bad points. People have one specific area they are better than others. I only praise students for their strengths. Students become more confident when they have praise.

Besides my strengths, I usually say compliments students. If you praise students, they think they are good at it. I constantly praised the students for their good points, and I saw their change like a miracle.

Let me talk about the driving force behind the achievements.

It was so tough that I thought to stop teaching students after doing it for only a year, but I continue to teach my students by watching them succeed in society. This has been continued for 30 years.

I only taught my students to escape poverty and give them a comfortable life in the future. I'm not a patriot, I'm just loyal to the work that's given me as a public servant. In other words, there is only a strong work ethic. I have a strong spirit of challenge and have adapted well to change without giving up. Perhaps this is the most important factor. Good choice and concentration are the second factors. The key point was to put the student in the right position and concentrate all the resources.

I will talk about the development process of South Korea.

It's about the late 1960s when I was in elementary school. Many people were too poor to

eat lunch. The United States supported flour and the school made bread with flour and gave it to the students. During lunchtime, many students went to the waterfront. Being hungry, the students comforted themselves with water. I remember the first time of eating bananas when I was in middle school in the late 1970s. When I was in elementary and middle school, Korea was not a country where lived well. There is nothing but human resources in Korea. We studied harder and worked harder while others slept.

There was no house, no factory, or anything else because the war between North and South Korea broke out in 1950. Imagine what Korea would have done if it had changed from nothing to the current development of Korea.

For 70 years before Korea became what it is today, Korea has been running forward. Even now, many places in Korean schools study until 10 p.m. The development of Korea did not happen overnight.

Next to where I worked, there is a place called Pohang Steel. Iron and coal are imported from foreign countries to produce iron. With a single factory, it is the largest one in the world, the world's most productive, and there are not many people working because of automation. Among the resources for producing iron, Korea only has a human resources.

The development of Korea was worked only by human power. Even now, most people in Korea are very sincere, hardworking, and concentrating hard on their work. This was the driving force behind the development of the country.



What do you want to be when you grow up?

Throughout our lives, we have heard the typical phrase “What do you want to be when you grow up?” Choosing a university degree is one of the most complicated decisions to make because it will mark our future life. Sometimes there is a clear vocation but it can happen that we do not get the degree we want because we do not get the necessary grade or, simply, we are not sure what to study.

There is always the question of what kind of degree I should choose or if I should choose according to what I like. We must also consider whether I have to give priority to economic expectations or if I have to look for a profession that guarantees a job without taking into account what I like ... and these are questions that are not easy to answer.

Even so, it is a process that we all go through, but when it comes to choosing a career, we have to ask ourselves the following questions: **What future will I have with that career? What opportunities will I get with the decision I have made?**

For this whole process, there are guidance practitioners whose role is crucial. These experts provide students with resources, tools, and opportunities to reflect on their future, expectations, and aspirations. They also help them to learn about the academic offer and to explore the labor market.

From here, we start from the premise that each person is unique and unrepeatable, so,

before any university degree selection, it is advisable:

- To analyze ourselves to know who we are and what we want to be in the future. When we analyze ourselves, we think about the types of activities we like or the work environment where we would like to work. What is the aim of this question? To define our profile and match it with the right job.
- Once we are clear about this, we have to start looking for university careers, for which it is necessary not to set limits!!! This will help us to get to know alternatives that were unknown until now, which can help us to become the professionals we dreamed of.
- It is also important that, once we have

drawn up this list of careers, we begin to evaluate them one by one.

- Finally, we will keep the ones we are most interested in, and, from there, we will ask and consult to reach a final decision. At

this point, it is important to count on the opinion of people who work in the field we would like to work in. We can ask them questions such as the pros and cons of the job or if they would choose that career

again.

We must read well, as universities usually have all the information on their websites: curricula, career opportunities, and itineraries. We also need to be well informed since the same degree can

have different subjects depending on the city. In addition, you will also have to find out how much the total costs are, considering that not everyone has the same financial possibilities, although there are many scholarships.

We must be flexible with ourselves, as making this type of decision will take time and we may not like the decision we make, but remember that it is **NEVER TOO LATE** to start again if we are not happy with the path we have chosen.

It may happen that with these criteria we are not clear about our choice, so we can look at two other factors that will help us to clarify our decision:

- ◆Vocation: studying what we have always liked. There are vocational orientation tests and other tools that help us to make decisions. Using vocational orientation tests, students carry out questionnaires on their professional interests and how these

relate to the different degrees on offer. On the other hand, in each country, there are usually institutional rankings of universities and their performance. Once we know the results of the universities that have good scores, we can look at their curricula, review the syllabuses and subjects of the degrees we want to study, and compare them with other universities.

◆Labour demand: the degree can also be chosen according to labor demand, as not all degrees have the same professional opportunities.

Finally, career choice is a personal process that involves thinking about the future. Knowing what careers are on offer, your personality, your interests, and your reality, you can choose your vocational path with more confidence, so don't be afraid because these are going to be the best years of your life, good luck with **your choice!**

Hence, no one is more influential and a role model than parents. This states their obligatory roles, values, and acceptable customs and traditions to their children on the importance of Education being the best legacy. According to **Dohner-Chávez, (2006), “Aside from ethnicity or economic background, parental involvement in children's education has a profound effect on a child's academic success”** (p.43). Researchers made it known that Educated parents have the right orientation in monitoring their children on academic performance than that non-educated parents. More so, Parents (family) are regarded as the first agent of social institutions that help to nurture and give the right orientation needed for a child's excellent performance in society. As this is also one of the major contemporary social problems affecting countries. Meanwhile, at this jet age, some countries do not still value “Education”, especially for their **Girl Childchildren**.

Types of Parents Involvement

The (Six) 6 major types of Parents' Involvement in their Child's Education, are as follows;

1. PARENTING: Parents can show their support for their children's education by attending school events such as open days, parent-teacher conferences, and school plays.

2. COMMUNICATING: Parents can stay informed about



their children's education by communicating with the school regularly. This can be done through Facebook, email, phone calls, or in-person meetings. Effective communication goes a long way in building cordial relationships.

3. VOLUNTEERING: Parents can contribute to their children's education by volunteering in the classroom or on a school committee.

4. LEARNING AT HOME: Parents can help their children with homework by providing guidance, support, and encouragement.

5. DECISION MAKING: Parents can have a voice in their children's education by participating in school decision-making processes, such as serving on a school committee or joining a parent-teacher organization.

6. COLLABORATING WITH COMMUNITY:

Parents can show their support by participating in fundraisers, attending school events, or becoming a member of the school Parent-Teacher Organization.

Importance of parental involvement in their child's education

Children spend the most time with their parents than with their teachers, friends, or other fam-

ily members. This means they have the greatest influence on children learning. Research has even indicated that parental or family involvement in children's education is a more accurate predictor of student achievement than social status or family income.

• Absenteeism is reduced – Absences of children from school not only hinder academic performance but also negatively affect children's social development. Frequent absenteeism causes a decrease in self-efficacy, social awareness, self-management, and students' growth mindset.

• Children's behavior is improved– Numerous studies highlight the relationship between parental involvement and disobedience. Little parental involvement will negatively impact a pupil's self-esteem, attitude toward school, behavior in the classroom, and ability to form relationships with others (peers or teachers).

• Academic performance is high– Academic performance is not solely about students' intellectual abilities. It compasses their motivation, study habits, self-esteem, and teacher-student relationships, all of which are influenced by parent interaction.

• Communication between

teachers and parents is improved – A good relationship between teacher and parent can help the school learn more about the student. This means teachers are better equipped to help pupils achieve their best. When teachers and parents work together, children learning and performances are greatly improved.

• A positive school culture is cultivated – Parenting and good communication between teachers and parents enable parents to develop an appreciation for the challenges faced by teachers. This appreciation and understanding can lead to greater support.

What are the negative effects on children without the caring of their parents?

• Deprived of parental care, they can endure physical, psychological, emotional, and social harm with consequences that last a lifetime.

• Children are also more likely to experience violence, abuse, neglect, and exploitation.

• These children tend to display deficits in cognition, attachment, emotional skills, and social skills.

Barriers / Challenges towards

• Parent Involvement

• Lack of time based on occupation.

• Economic constraints,

• Parental stress/depression levels.

• Lack of support.

• Lack of knowledge, skills, and confidence.

Parental Involvement Benefits on their children's education.

Parental involvement has many positive effects on both child and parent. Some of the benefits of parental involvement for children are:

A significantly increased cognitive development, an improvement in the child's motivation, a stronger parent-child relationship, and of course, increased academic achievement.

Some of the benefits parental involvement has on parents are gaining a more positive attitude about themselves and their parenting skills, increased self-confidence, and increased satisfaction with their children's school and faculty at the school (**Becher, 2001**). There are many benefits to parents' involvement in their elementary school children's lives, but, possibly the most important benefit is in helping the children's academic achievement.

Advice to parents.

• Teach your children social skills.

• Spend quality time with your children.

• Be a good role model.

• Praise and encourage your children.

Recommendation

Provide positive feedback and motivate your children. Good role models in parents, caregivers, and teachers should model and encourage an active lifestyle for children. Praise, reward, and encourage children/adolescents to be active. Being active as a family is a great way to model and encourage physical activity. Spending more time with them by asking “how their day went”, effective communication, visiting their schools during the open day and conferences, continuous coaching, volunteering in the school engagement, and then checking on their books, assignment, and assessment in their respective of their busy schedule or nature of the job.

Clean water and sanitation

The Sustainable Development Goals are a set of 17 goals and 169 indicators that all UN member states agree to achieve a better and more sustainable future.

To achieve the goals of sustainable development, it is necessary to place children at the center of the state's strategy and action plan.

Today I will touch on one of the Sustainable Development Goals, Clean Water and Sanitation.

Clean water available to all is an integral part of the kind of world we want to live in, and we have enough clean water on the planet to achieve this goal. Despite the above, due to poor economy or lack of infrastructure, millions of people, including children, die every year from diseases caused by lack of water, unsanitary conditions, and lack of hygiene standards.

Drought affects the world's poorest countries, worsening hunger rates. Fortunately, significant progress has been made in drinking water supply and sanitation over the past decade. According to this progress, more than 90% of the world's population has access to improved sources of drinking water.

Rational use of drinking water. As banal as it may sound, society needs to be reminded of it every day. We should not reduce water consumption at the expense of reducing water intake, but this should be expressed in such actions as closing the tap while brushing teeth, reducing the duration of bathing, constantly checking the plumbing, and using dishes and washing machines only when they are maximally loaded. By implementing these actions, I have been small for several years, but I think I have taken an important step to contribute to the preservation of clean water. We must also remember that the rational use of water significantly reduces our costs and has a positive impact on the budget, and this should be one of the main motivators for society.

New technologies: the widespread introduction and use of new technologies in everyday life is another step forward in solving the water problem. Today, there are many innovative tools at the mercy of inventors and scientists. For example faucet lip - Altered Nozzle - a special faucet lip divides the water flow into a million drops and sprays it with high pressure, as a result, we use only 2% of the water. Lifestrat is a brilliant example of innovative technology - a personal water filter that cleans all water from bacteria for almost 100 %, the invention is already used in African countries. It is the mass use of such technologies that significantly ensures the availability and protection of clean water supplies. Tap water in developed countries usually meets drinking water standards, yet only a small fraction uses it for food preparation. On the other hand, it is used for washing, toilets, and irrigation.

Water covers about 70% of the Earth's surface. About 97.2% of it is salty, and only 2.8% is fresh. Drinking water is available in almost every inhabited place on earth, but the necessary infrastructure can be expensive to build and unable to reach people.

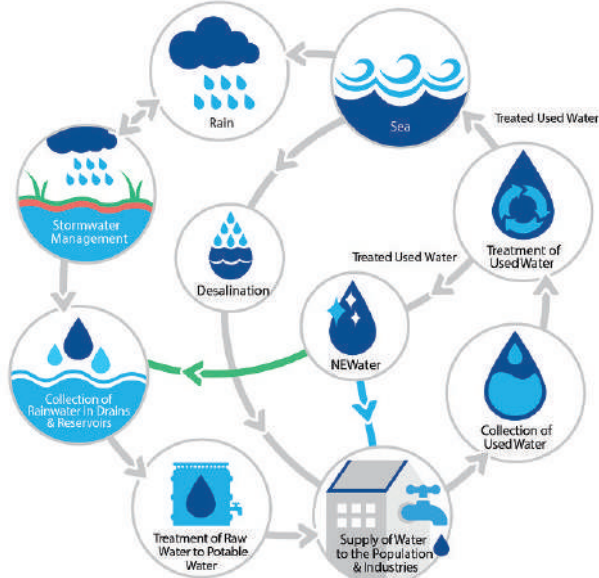
Bottled water is mostly used for drinking. Tap water, which is supplied to household systems, moves through pipes. To make

this water transfer safe for consumption, various substances must be added to it to purify it and meet the drinking water standard.

The amount of drinking water per day is individual. It depends on physical activity, age, health, and environment. Under normal climate conditions, the daily norm of water is about 2.7 liters for adult women and 3.7 liters for adult men. Physical exercise and exposure to heat cause water loss and therefore thirst. active individuals living in hot climates may have a daily water requirement of 6 liters or more. The

European Food Safety Organization recommends 2 liters of water per day for adult women and 2.5 liters per day for adult men.

Water is an essential component of the body, accounting for approximately 60% of the body weight in men and 55% in women. A child is made up of 70% to 80% water, while the body of an elderly person is about 45%.

Drinking water quality parameters are usually divided into three categories. these are:

1. Physical
2. Chemical
3. Microbiological

Physical and chemical parameters include heavy metals, organic matter, and other solid materials, while microbiological parameters include bacteria, specific pathogenic species of bacteria (for example, those that cause cholera), viruses, and other parasites.

Adherence to chemical parameters reduces the risk of contamination, although substances such as nitrates, nitrites, and arsenic have a more direct impact. Physical parameters include controlling the spirit, appearance, and taste of drinking water. In the world, water is most polluted by sewage, in particular by human fecal pathogens and parasites. In 2006, 1.8 million people died from water-borne diseases, and an estimated 1.1 billion people

lacked clean drinking water. In some parts of the world, the only source of water is wells, springs, etc., which are often contaminated with sewage.

Also according to various tests, out of 159 water samples, 83% of them were contaminated with plastic fibers.

It is also important to get the minerals that drinking water contains. Inorganic minerals are generally found in surface water and groundwater. The cleaning process affects the compounds of various substances, such as calcium, zinc, manganese, phosphate, fluoride, and sodium compounds. Practically all drinking water contains many types of elements, some of which participate in the body's metabolism. For example, sodium, potassium, and chloride are found in small amounts in most waters, and these elements are important for the body. Others, such as fluoride, although beneficial in low concentrations, cause disease in high concentrations.

To have clean water, it is necessary to follow each of the directions that I have mentioned. If we take care of our nature, follow hygienic norms, and do not use excessive water that we do not need, our nature will also respond positively and we will be able to save our planet.

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"How to Find your Educational and Career Paths"

While the question of "how to choose your college" might appear to be a merely practical one, requiring equally pragmatic advice, which should lead to subsequent decisions of similar sort and considerations the larger issue here, namely, "how to choose, find and follow or abandon and change a career trajectory" is a philosophical question with existential and ethical implications.

The wandering Ukrainian philosopher and teacher Hryhoriy Skovoroda (1722-1794), often called the "Ukrainian or Russian Socrates" as well as the "Diogenes of Kharkiv," and "our own Pythagoras," insisted that we should all follow our own callings, passions, and natural inclinations rather than the expectations of society, which imposes false hierarchies and fake prefabricated codes of behavior and paths of life that lead to disappointments and resentments.

It is much more beneficial for communities and salutary for the individual, Skovoroda claimed, to be, for example, a good cobbler, who enjoys their craft, than say a misguided lawyer or even worse, an incompetent medical doctor. The thinker himself preferred the life of a peripatetic poet and sage over the governmental or ecclesiastical positions repeatedly offered to him in his youth. "The world tried to ensnare me, but I escaped" is written on the philosopher's grave inscribed according to his own wishes and instructions.

As much as my inclination here might be to continue providing my audiences with proper references to the wisdom of thinkers I admire, if I were still required to provide a list of 'my own' recommendations regarding choosing one's education and career paths, it would be as follows:

• **Choose your teachers, not just universities.**

Do not only research the colleges and universities you would like to attend but look also at particular professors and their research in the de-

partments of your interest. Carefully go over the courses offered and whenever possible read through the syllabi as well as the research and teaching profiles of the instructors. Consider your topics as well as potential teachers, supervisors, and mentors.

• **Ideally, you'll be learning from your peers and environ-**



ment as well.

After carefully studying the departments and scholars of the institutions of higher education of your interest, make sure to also look at their student body descriptions and profiles. Ask yourself: would you like to spend years of learning with and among these people? Make sure both the environment and the culture of the campus appear welcoming as well as intellectually, socially, and aesthetically appealing to you. You learn from your surroundings as well as friends and colleagues not only from your academic instructors.

• **Develop your talents and follow your passions.**

When thinking of your major and fields of study, make sure not to give into considering only current job market conditions and the illusions of promised security, but also and much more importantly your own interests, passions, and inclinations. Market conditions change as history and

contemporary news repeatedly prove to us. So, make sure to dedicate your life and work to worthwhile efforts and careers that align with your talents, passions, and the good you can do in this world during your lifetime.

• **Apply to colleges and universities of your dreams, not only "safety schools."**
